To make a Peace Medal nomination:

- **Complete the Registration Form**
- **Answer the following applicable questions within 2 typed, single-spaced pages**

ADULT PEACE MEDAL

For an INDIVIDUAL

- Describe the peace work performed.
- Does, or has, the peace work help change people's lives? Describe.
- Does the peace work create a long-term, sustainable impact on individuals or the community? Describe.
- What are the nominee's roles and responsibilities?
- Describe any collaboration with other groups or individuals.
- How does this individual demonstrate the values and qualities of peace through the work they have done and in their interactions with others?

For a GROUP

- Provide a brief history of the organization or group.
- Describe the peace work performed.
- Does, or has, the peace work help change people's lives? Describe.
- Does the peace work create a long-term, sustainable impact on individuals or the community? Describe.
- What were the group's roles and responsibilities?
- Describe any collaboration with other groups or individuals.
- How does this group demonstrate the values and qualities of peace through the work they have done and in their interactions with others?

YOUTH PEACE MEDAL

For an INDIVIDUAL

- Describe the peace work performed.
- What were this person's roles and responsibilities?
- Describe any collaboration with other groups or individuals.
- How does this individual demonstrate the values and qualities of peace through the work they have done and in their interactions with others?

For a GROUP

- Provide a brief history of the organization or group.
- Describe the peace activities performed.
- What were the group's roles and responsibilities?
- Describe any collaboration with other groups or individuals.
- What has been the impact/result of the peace activities?
- How does this group demonstrate the values and qualities of peace through the work they have done and in their interactions with others?
